



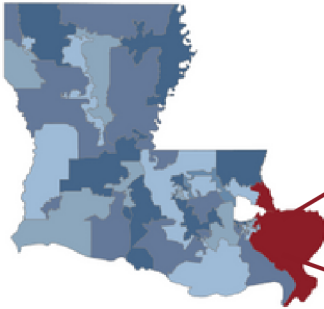

### Kindergarten Immunization Rates Declining in Louisiana

High immunization rates protect Louisiana children from diseases like polio, measles, and whooping cough.

95% of a community needs to be immunized to prevent an outbreak of measles.

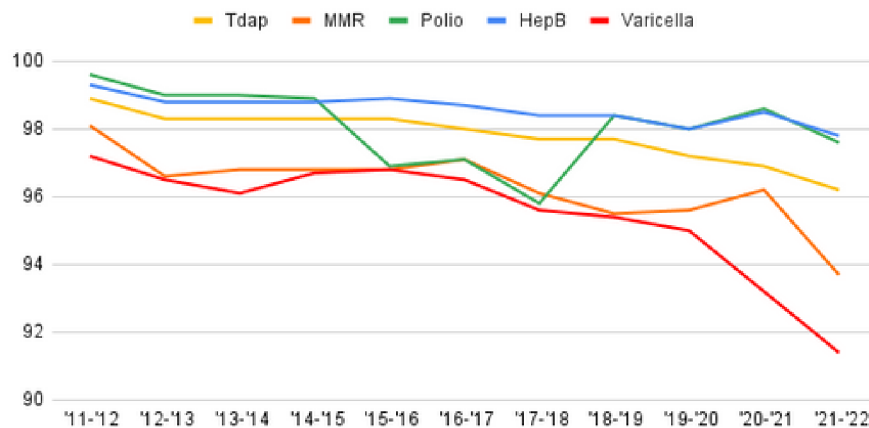
